Falkland Islands

We did not receive news of the Global Day of Prayer until the first week of May, which gave us little time to prepare! However, the information CDs you couriered to us arrived in time (thank you!) and proved very useful. Meanwhile I had accessed the website and downloaded much of the information and material available there.

This is a small community (total civilian population only around 2,600: 2,000 of whom live in Stanley and 600 scattered across the two large and many smaller islands). There are excellent relations between the different denominations here: we meet regularly for joint services and work together on various charitable projects. I contacted leaders of the other churches with information on GDOP, but I guess they must have been particularly busy because no-one replied!

So in 2006 GDOP has been a small-scale event, as far as Falkland's participation is concerned. Some members of Christ Church Cathedral (Anglican) took printed copies of the 10 days prayer background and several others (including one friend in England) opted to receive the prayer backgrounds daily by e-mail. This worked especially well for one of the travelling teachers, who was so delighted with the prayer backgrounds that she is keeping them to use as a resource for her own daily prayer in the future. We were all impressed by the thoroughness with which the backgrounds were prepared and by their scope and range.

We kept the GDOP in mind through all our Pentecost services. The main service was broadcast by F.I.R.S. our national radio station, and the story of GDOP was also told on the Sunday afternoon Christian music programme. At the main service, after a brief explanation and history of GDOP from 2000, we heard: 2 Chronicles 7:11-18; Habakkuk 2:1-14; Acts 2:1-21. Then we prayed the Prayer for the World, using a series of picture images to illustrate the different concerns covered by the prayer. It was really exciting for our isolated congregation to feel that we were joining with our Christian brothers and sisters worldwide in prayer and worship. The travelling teacher (mentioned above) was most moved by the photos of worshippers in Africa, which she said reminded her of when she lived and worshipped in Nigeria. Even in our small congregation (about 50 people) we had people from the Falkland Islands, from Britain, Australia, Brazil and St Helena. (I do not know whether you contacted St Helena in time for them to join in GDOP 2006 - but the message has certainly gone back to them now and I hope they will participate in 2007.) We gave out prayer cards with Habakkuk 2:14 and Matthew 6:10 to take home and use over the coming month as a reminder of the challenge to go out and bless the community. (We are following up over the next 3 weeks with short articles in our church news-sheet suggesting ways in which both adults and children can be a blessing to their Christian and non-Christian neighbours in this place.)

It was great to be part of this world-wide event. Next year, with more time to prepare and publicise GDOP, I hope that all the churches here will become involved and that we will be able to meet together during the 10 days of preparation

With many thanks for all the hard work and effort you and your colleagues have put into this event. We loved being part of it and are already looking forward to next year.

The whole town benefits from the influx of people and the money they bring into the town. This is the town where we met to pray for the nation and repent for idolatry and witchcraft. Thank you for organizing the Global Day of Prayer. Haiti will never be the same again, and God is just beginning with us.

Radio Paradise - the first sub-station of TBN changed its programming to accommodate persons live on radio. [Radio Paradise is heard across the globe - Germany, Sweden, Australia, New Zealand and the like.] Prayers went up from across the nation by pastors, spiritual leaders, intercessors and the like. One Haitian residing in Miami called and prayed for his native Haiti among other nations. Our prayers shook the gates of hell. Prayers for the LION & the EAGLE - UK & USA- the nations spear heading the fight against evil - indeed, the fight against spiritual Babylon. This fight is making the path straight for the Kingdom of God to be established in IRAQ - hence breaking through against the Prince of Persia, even as Daniel prayed. We prayed for those leaders who are bearing such rebuke at the hands of persons who see only in the natural. We prayed for their vindication. God's time has come. We now receive the news of the capture of AL-ZARQAWI in death. Also the long awaited news of the swearing in of two cabinet members of the Iraqi government. What a God!

To top this off, was the Grand chorus of Praise. It was as if God said, "After you have prayed, praise me." Glorious praise ascended from around the globe - our nation doing its part, as we praised non-stop for 24 hours from 6 pm on Monday June 5th, to 6 pm on Tuesday June 6th. Yes, it was the GLOBAL DAY of PRAISE on 06/06/06. We cut across the plans the enemy had for his celebration of 666. **Our God has done it again. He gets all the glory and all the praise.**

This was then followed by another period of worship unto the Lord. There was spontaneous dancing and praising the Lord for "His goodness and His wonderful works to the children of men."

On the day, we had twenty-one ministers of the Gospel present, many of them prayed, but others just participated in the time of prayer.

We do thank God for the opportunity He gave us to be in His presence on that day. We do look forward to cooperating with Him as we seek to have His Kingdom come on earth as it is in heaven.

Belize

Dearest Global Day of Prayer Team. First off, thank YOU for all your work on behalf of this project, to mobilize Christians all over the world into prayer for God's purposes to be fulfilled. Below is the report for Belmopan, Belize.

Location: Belmopan (Capitol city) in front of Parliamentary building

Attendance: 1200-1500

We had an excellent team dynamic with different pastors & leaders from the area coming together with a strong spirit of partnership, humility, and togetherness. The different participating churches all agreed to contribute financially to cover the costs so we wouldn't have to take up an offering. It was a great team effort.

Program - After a brief time of upbeat praise, there was a short sharing of the GDOP vision, then we watched the 10 minute video downloaded from the GDOP web site to stir vision and help people see they are part of a global move. The video was followed by a song from 2 Chron 7:14 to set the tone for the time. One leader led the participants into a time of repentance to prepare the way for breakthroughs in our time together. This was followed up by entering into a "concert of prayer" where different leaders led out in prayer, each section being targeted with a Belize and local prayer thrust, then followed with a GLOBAL prayer focus in that same prayer topic.

The 5 areas of prayer focus were...

1. **The Church** - we hold the keys and we are God's change agents on the earth...
2. **For Kingdom leaders to be raised up for the "7 Influencing Areas of Society"** in Belize and the World (being Church, Govt., Family, Education, Arts & Entertainment, Media, & Business/Commerce)
3. **Sexual Crimes & Internet Pornography** - there has been a rise in sex crimes that has gone together with the expansion of internet pornography, and we felt led to tackle this in prayer locally & globally...
4. **For World Evangelization & Unreached People Groups**, spec. emphasis on Islam... Also for Christian workers labouring in these nations...
5. **For the fulfilment of Hab. 2** - that God's glory cover the earth...

We concluded in a time of worship, declaring God's glory over the earth, and our commitment to be part of that process. We anticipate seeing the breakthroughs that will come from this, as well as hearing back reports of global participation... Thanks again!!!

*Meu nome é José Julio e sou pastor-missionário neste campo, a serviço da JMN - Junta de Missões Nacionais da IPB - Igreja Presbiteriana do Brasil. Tive notícia da CAMPANHA MUNDIAL DE ORAÇÃO uns 20 dias antes da data. Não tivemos tempo de nos organizar melhor. Passei um manifesto que fiz, com base no histórico que li na Internet e passei para três pastores, um da IEQD - Igreja do Evangelho Quadrangular; outro da Batista e outro da Igreja Evangélica Assembléia de Deus - eles ficaram de convocar suas igrejas para orar especificamente. Não tive notícia sobre como foi com eles.
Em nossa pequena comunidade missionária tivemos diversos, e abençoados, momentos de clamor e intercessão:
Dia 25.05 realizamos um culto de oração, em nosso templo, com a presença de 12 pessoas (dando início a Campanha). Intercedemos pelas nações, pela Igreja de Cristo no mundo, pelos pastores e missionários e suas respectivas famílias; pelos povos não-alcanceados. Dia 26.05 tivemos uma devocional na COSAMAR - Cooperativa de Materiais Recicláveis de São Mateus do Sul - entidade que nasceu a partir de reuniões em nosso templo e hoje cerca de 15 famílias vivem desse trabalho, reconhecido e incentivado municipalmente; havia cerca de 22 pessoas, entre associados e pessoal do SINE - Sistema Nacional de Emprego e duas assistentes sociais da Prefeitura. Explicamos sobre a Campanha de oração para os presentes - a grande maioria não-evangélica.
Dia 27.05 recebemos a visita de 33 irmãs da Federação das Sociedades Auxiliadoras Femininas, do Sínodo de Curitiba e no Culto, onde havia cerca de 55 presentes, nos reunimos em pequenos grupos de 3 a 5 pessoas para orar uns pelos outros e por avivamento na Igreja de N.S.Jesus Cristo. No dia 04.06 oramos com as crianças que evangelizamos num bairro carente - cerca de 30 presentes - explicando os motivos da Campanha e Dia Mundial de Oração. Eles participaram ativamente.
