WHY L-10-T?

Jesus was a thirty-year-old radical in the society in which he lived. He was not someone's old man or a minister of a church - He was one of us! But He was GOD! He had a perfect relationship with Father GOD. He lived a lifestyle of no reputation for His Father. He took all our sins upon Himself and died for us. His only requirement was that we copy His lifestyle!

How are you currently following Jesus in your lifestyle?

He trained twelve disciples - ordinary people like you and me. He chose them to take His message to the ends of the earth. He also sent seventy (or seventy two NIV, Good News Bible, etc.) others, to take the message ahead of Him. They are the examples that we follow in L-10-T for modern life!

Before Jesus went to heaven to be with the Father He gave a very important instruction called the Great Commission:

19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. (Mat 28:19-20a)

STEP 2: FELLOWSHIP

To fellowship with the people wherever you go, whether it is school, varsity, work or just where you hang out. Be friendly and normal and use the normal lingo. NO Christianese!

For the poor disciples in Jesus' time this step was really difficult, because they had a lot of religious stuff to consider, such as what kind of food they were allowed to eat and how to prepare it. We do not have that concern!

When hanging out with friends, it is important not to compromise, like swearing, getting drunk, getting high, having sex before you are married or to do anything against your moral values. What can you think of that we should do while hanging out with friends?

Think of some of the words or phrases which you use when you are around people. Do these words put some people off Jesus because you are using them? Can you use those phrases in front of Jesus? Because, by the way, He is there, you just aren't looking out for Him.

STEP 3: MEETING NEEDS

What do you understand about meeting people's needs? _____

In step 3 you respond to the immediate needs of the people you meet wherever you go. One of your friends might express a need such as, a parent who has become ill, the need for money to catch a bus/taxi, the loss of a job, family member or pet, the need of finances for further studies of many others. If you hear about such a need, you might, at an appropriate time, assist by giving some money (only if you can) or give a helping hand and/or by praying about the need bringing His BIG HAND in to assist!

There are **three levels** of prayer in Step 3:

- 1) You might pray softly or with a friend (everyone can do this!)
- 2) Ask the person if you might pray for the need with him/her. This should be a simple prayer with the person involved, usually away from the group.
- 3) You may ask a person if they have a need that you can pray for (everyone is walking around with some or other need or desire).

The wonderful thing about praying for a need is that if you ask a person if it is okay to pray for the need, most people - Christian, Muslim, Hindu, New Age or atheist - will say yes.



IF they say No - then you simply turn away and pray for them anyway.

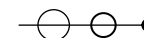

STEP 4: TELL ABOUT JESUS

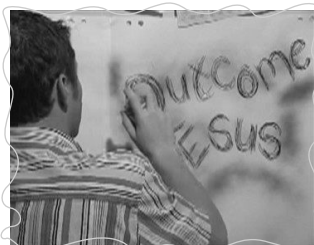

The L-10-T Effect



L-10-T changes lives firstly yours and then those with whom you L-10-T.

Let us read what happened to the Luke 10 disciples as they returned:

17 The seventy-two returned with joy and said, "Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name." 18 He replied, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. 19 I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you. (Luke 10:17-19)

Likewise ordinary people like you and me will return from wherever we have been during the week with glowing faces and reports of the wonders that GOD has done in the lives of the people touched by Him.

Example

We also learn that we do not have to _____. When you start with L-10-T it is good to do it with a friend (Remember that Jesus sent the disciples out two-two.) But if you do not have someone with you, you do not have to delay your L-10-T-ing.

ALWAYS find a place where you can report back as the disciples did when they returned. A once a week report back or debriefing. Which can happen at school with a friend or teacher or in a group setting. You may also

report back in your cell group, congregation (on Sundays) or Sunday school.

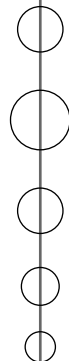

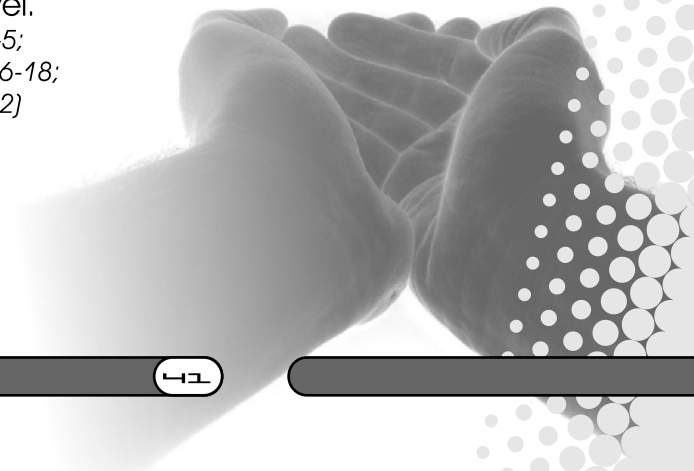

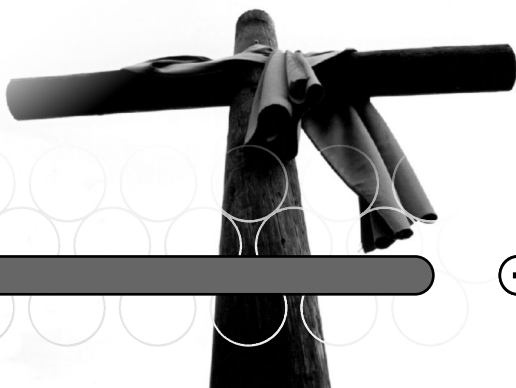

INTRODUCTION

Thanks so much for choosing a "No Reputation" lifestyle for your life! The youth generation will pay the price to see a lost world reached with the message of Christ's love for them. You are encouraged to "count the cost" before following Christ. Jesus said to His disciples in Luke 14:26,27,33 the following: "If anyone comes to me and does not hate... even his own life - he cannot be my disciple. And anyone who does not carry his own cross and follow me cannot be my disciple. In the same way, any of you who does not give up everything he has cannot be my disciple." **This is a clear call to a "No Reputation" lifestyle!**

Many have given their lives for the sake of Christ over many centuries. Our idea of a martyr has always been someone who has given his or her life on the mission field in a faraway land but that is no longer the case. The modern day martyr who is wearing sneakers, jeans and a back pack is as close as your school campus. The gunshots, which have taken the lives of student missionaries, have sounded a new era for a generation in the church. Many student missionaries may not be called on to give their physical lives but they will certainly be called to die to their own desires.

There are three ingredients to living a lifestyle of "No Reputation" according to Philippians 2. The first ingredient is in verse 5 where it says, **"Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus."** Attitudes are outward expressions of inward feelings. The outward expressions of a generation are changing towards their unsaved friends. Youth are eliminating their fear and pride, which is releasing outward expressions of love to their friends.

You then find it says in verse 7, **"But made himself (Jesus) of no reputation."** As we are willing to adjust our attitudes we are ready to consider the "No Reputation" lifestyle that Jesus lived. He was a servant, he humbled himself, and He was obedient even to death on a cross. I pray this training will prepare you for that kind of lifestyle.

PRAYER God, I bow my knee in humility to you.
I know your loving presence will be with me all day.
Thank you for loving me today. I love you, too.

"Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus." (Phil 2:5 NIV)

Attitudes are outward expressions of your inward feelings! What's happening on the inside will be expressed on the outside. Many inward feelings seem to be keeping a generation from experiencing the love of Christ. Attitude adjustments must take place for God's love to flow in and through us. This first ten-second prayer, while on your knees, is to show an outward expression of your inward feelings of love for God. When you kneel, that posture reflects your heart, a humble heart to serve the Lord. You will have established a "vertical passion" for God first!

Vertical Passion

"If you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any fellowship with the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and purpose... Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus..." (Philippians 2: 1,2,5 NIV)

- Day 7: Prayer walk alone and let God know how much you love Him.
- Day 8: Go to your favorite place for one hour with your Bible and a note pad. Write your thoughts on Psalms 37.
- Day 9: Find a quiet place and just listen for God's voice to speak.
- Day 10: Take a walk and let God's creation remind you of Him. (Romans 1:20)
- Day 11: No TV today. Fast it.
- Day 12: Join with a friend and share about your love for God with each other (by phone, Instant Messenger or in person)
- Day 13: Create your own day
- Day 14: Meditate on Philippians 2: 1-4
- Day 15: No phone today. Fast it.
- Day 16: Praise God for all the things you can think of today. Make a list.
- Day 17: No video games today. Fast it.
- Day 18: Have a worship time with some friends today.
- Day 19: No computer. Fast it.
- Day 20: Spend 1/2 hour with God in worship, prayer and the Word. (Psalms 95)
- Day 21: Plan a night with some friends to share your passion experience and then turn the rest of the night into your own Vertical Passion night.

God, Touch them

PRAYER God, touch the teachers, administration, and students on my campus today. One touch from you, Father, can change someone's destiny. Touch them through me.

"...love your neighbor as yourself." (Matthew 22:39)

"but (Jesus) made himself of no reputation" (Phil. 2:7, KJV)

A reputation is a favorable and publicly recognized name. Jesus challenged you to a lifestyle of "No Reputation" when He called you to follow Him. The Millennial Generation has already experienced martyrs on the mission field called, the campus. Many other millennial youth are laying down their personal desires for the "No Reputation" lifestyle. This second ten-second prayer is centered around loving and serving those on your campus. Once your heart is filled with "vertical passion" you are prepared to release compassion!

Horizontal Compassion

"Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others...but (Jesus) made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death even death on a cross!" (Phil. 2:3,4,7, NIV) (*"no reputation" KJV).*

God, Tell them

PRAYER God, the message of Jesus' love for my campus must be told. Use me as the messenger. I will tell those around me how much you love them.

"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations..." (Matthew 28:19)

"that at the name of Jesus every knee should bowÉ and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord" (Phil.2:10,11, NIV)

A lifestyle is a person's approach to living, which includes such things as moral attitudes, social choices, and financial decisions. Every area of our life should reflect Jesus! Adjusting our attitudes and reputations will now allow us to live a lifestyle that looks like Jesus, acts like Jesus, and smells like Jesus!
